1.00	Opening	
1.01	The meeting started at exactly 1:06 pm with the recitation of the NBA Prayer by Amb. Mike Omotoso.	
2.00	Chairman's opening remarks	
2.01	The Chairman welcomed members attending the meeting both physically and virtually. He also thanked the visitors for sparing time to identify with the Branch. Given the long agenda for the meeting, he indicated that effective use of time will be strived at, so as to round up the meeting in good time. He concluded by stating that as far as practicable, reports from standing and ad hoc committees already circulated, will be adopted at the meeting.	
3.00	Review and adoption of the minutes of the last meeting.	
3.01	The Secretary, Nta Ekpiken highlighted the minutes of the meeting held on 14 February, 2022 and then invited comments and observations from members.	
3.02	There were no comments, Nathalia Odidika moved the motion for adoption of the minutes and same was seconded by Tosin Olabisi.	
4.00	Matters arising from minutes of last meeting	
4.01	Building project: The chairman informed the House that the ground floor has reached advanced stage at the Bar center. He also informed the House that a Certificate of Work already done and that the Building Committee was reviewing same. He further reiterated his advice to members to visit the site from time to time, noting that such act would impress it on the contractors to do a decent job.	
4.02	Branch Bus: The Chairman informed the House that the Chairman of the Bus Committee would brief the House on the latest development regarding the Branch Bus.	
4.03	Law Week: The Chairman informed members that during the course of the meeting, the Chairman of the Law Week Committee would address the House on the law week billed for 18-25 March, 2022.	
5.00	Knowledge Sharing Session:	
5.01	Mr. Beulah Adeoye-Partner & West Africa Forensic Leader Deloitte Nigeria a presentation on the topic: " The Role of Electronic Discovery in the Lawyer's Toolbox ". The Speaker provided invaluable insights on the dynamics of electronic discovery of documents in the context of 21 st century law practice.	

He identified the current legislative limitations to attain fulsome electronic discovery regime in Nigeria. He identified the role of technology in electronic discovery; the distinction between traditional and e-discovery; how to utilize electronic stored information; the dynamics of privacy and data protection in the context of electronic document discovery, and the benefits of e-discovery to the modern-day lawyer's work. He concluded by sharing some digital forensic technologies like ABBY, Relativity, e.t.c which are necessary tools to navigating the clearly emerging area of practice in Nigeria.

- 5.02 The Chairman called on Mr. Egun Olu-Adegboruwa, SAN to thank Mr. Adeoye for the well delivered presentation after a question-and-answer session that followed.

Special presentation by the Chartered Institute of Chartered Secretaries and Administrators

- 5.03 The Deputy Registrar of the Institute, Ms. Oladunmi Ogunselere made a presentation on the courses and programs offered by the Institute. She also announced a specially discounted package for lawyers of 1-15 years; and 15 years and above, up to 20% discount of the total package and urged members to take advantage of the promo while it lasts.

Treasurer's report:

- 6.00 The Treasurer gave a run-down of the financial position of the Branch for the month of February. The report was adopted for deliberation by Mr. Ogbonnaya Agbafo; and same was seconded by Mr. Abioye Akerele.

7.00 Reports from Standing and Ad-hoc Committees

- 7.01 **Dinner Committee:** Mrs. Oyinkasola Badejo-Okusanya presented a detailed report of the Committee stating the funds received, expenditure, difficulties encountered during the committee's work, as well as recommendations to avert such challenges in the future, particularly the need to set up the Committee on time; and to appoint persons who are willing and available to volunteer their time and resources to the committee's work.

- 7.02 The Chairman invited Mr. Zik Obi (II) to commend members of the Committee for the wonderful job they did. This was after members gave feedback on the event.

- 7.03 **Law Week Committee:** The Chairman of the Committee, Mr. Wale Adesokan, SAN informed the House that all was set for the Law Week. He assured members that their expectations would be surpassed as the committee's had gone the extra mile to deliver an outstanding law week.

7.04 **Land Registry Committee:** Mr. Lekan Badejo briefed the House of the progress it has made so far with respect to the issues faced by members in engaging with the Land Registry. He particularly mentioned the visit to the Registrar of Titles, and the Chief Judge of Lagos State. He mentioned that they were asked by the Chief Judge to articulate all the concerns in a memo, which they had since done, and now awaiting further directives in that regard. He also informed the House of the Registry's acknowledgment of the issues and some of the steps being taken to address them, particularly efforts at digitizing engagement with the Registry through a mobile app which is being built.

7.05 **Human Rights Committee:** The Chairman of the Committee Mrs. Abiye Tam-George briefed the House of its prison visitation and audit exercise which held on 16th and 22nd February, 2022 at the Ikoyi Correctional Facility. He articulated the successes made thus far including the bail of some inmates and the successful striking-out of charges brought against some of the inmates. She solicited the support of members in the *pro bono* exercise as the Committee was facing man-power issues.

7.06 In response to this. Mr. Egun Olu-Adegboruwa SAN suggested that going forward, issuance of Letter of Good Standing by the Branch should be pre-conditioned on successful handling of a number of pro-bono cases; a proposal which the Chairman promised would be looked into by the Branch given the constitutional implications.

7.07 **Welfare Committee:** Mrs. Jean Chiazor Anishere SAN briefed the House of the work being done by the Committee in the areas of generating a data of person living with disabilities in the Branch so as to cater to their needs; the efforts being made to ensure that members take full benefit of the NBA National Health Insurance program; and finally she mentioned that through the efforts of the Committee's sub-committee, lawyer's wears and books were sold at the previous meeting of the Branch at a discounted rate, and sought the approval of the Branch Executives for such bonanza to be held at every meeting of the Branch.

7.08 **Data Management and Membership Committee:** Mr. Emuobunuvie Majemite informed the House that the Committee has been able to identify a consultant who will help with management of the Branch's data and ancillary matters and that it was awaiting the approval of the Branch Executives.

7.09 On the need to have a clean data of members of the Branch, it was agreed that a provision be made in the Branch website to

disclose the actual identity of all the fully registered and financial members of the Branch. The Chairman in this regard informed the House that the Branch has so far, a clean data of over 5,000 members who have paid their dues and that the Branch can build from that in embarking on this exercise.

7.10 **Remuneration Committee:** Mr. Agbada S. Agbada highlighted in delivering the Committee's report, highlighted the innovations in the report of the NBA Remuneration Committee which is billed for deliberation by the NBA National at an emergency NEC meeting scheduled for 17 February, 2022. He noted the proposed reports contain far-reaching recommendations some of which would warrant amendment of the Legal Practitioners Act. He concluded that the outcome of the deliberations would be reported to the House in the next meeting.

8.00 **Any other Business/State of the Nation/State of the Lagos Bar**

8.01 By way of A.O.B, the Chairman clarified the reports in the media regarding the investigation of some financial activities of the Branch by EFCC and ICPC based on an anonymous petition. He stated that the Branch has made statements at the EFCC and the matter was still being investigated, as the subject of the inquest relates to the activities of the previous EXCO of the Branch particularly with respect of the proposed Bar centre.

8.02 Hon. Babatunde Ogala SAN and Alex Muoka in their respective reactions, wondered why the petition was written by an anonymous fellow, noting that it was an act that borders on mischief. They noted that anyone who has an issue with the way the finances of the Branch is run, should be bold enough to engage such matters through the available channels, rather than proceeding to embarrass the Branch and by extension, the legal profession.

8.03 Mr. Rotimi Oyedepo who is a Lawyer with the Commission assured the House that he would intervene to see that the issue is addressed to a logical conclusion and promised to report back by the next meeting. He concluded by urging the House that the move was not aimed at tarnishing the image of the profession, as he too would be a victim if that were the case.

8.04 In light of the intervention of Mr. Oyedepo, the Chairman urged that no more comments be made in respect of the matter.

8.05 **Constitution of Young Lawyers Forum EXCO**

Following the clarification by the President Mr. Olumide Akpata that elections cannot be held by Foras of the NBA, the chairman has constituted below the new YLF exco

8.06 Mr. Adebola Lema condemned the utterances of the Ebonyi State Governor, Dave Umahi following the judgment of the Federal High Court sacking him from office. He also commended the strong worded statement of the NBA President, Olumide Akpata condemning such choice of language and then moved a motion that the Branch commend the NBA President for his statement.

8.07 The Chairman equally commended the NBA President for his well-written statement and also indicated the Branch will be writing to him in that regard.

8.08 Mr. Seth Ahmaefule of the History and Legacy Committee condemned the sharp practice going on at the magistrate court where persons who are granted bail are subjected to all kinds of difficulties to perfect their bail conditions particularly the menace of charging exorbitant fees for inspection and/or confirmation of sureties amongst other issues.

8.09 The Chairman noted that this issue will be referred to the Human Rights Committee for prompt action.

8.10 Mr. Henry Nwokike complained about issues with assessing and/or navigating the Branch website. The Chairman directed him to send his phone number and email address so that the issue will be looked into.

9.02 **Adjournment:** A motion for adjournment of the meeting was moved by Mr. Kehinde Dawodu and same was seconded by Obinna Henry.
